TELEPHONE CHARGES

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

IMMIGRATION:

Jamaican Immigration and Customs: Log on to <https://enterjamaica.gov.jm/> and complete your C5 Immigration & Customs Declaration Form. The form is free of cost.

Passports: All international trips require a Passport valid for at least 6 months beyond the date of departure. Any and all additional Visa's or travel documents required are the sole responsibility of the traveler.

Travel Insurance: CENTERPIECE EVENT & TRAVEL GROUP, LLC offers Travel Protection Purchase through the supplier chosen and outlined on the Travel Insurance Credit Card Authorization Form that can help minimize the monetary loss incurred due to unforeseen events beyond my control such as: cancellation, missed connections, baggage loss, trip delay, and especially medical emergencies.

The cost of my travel Insurance is nonrefundable and any refund issued for covered reasons will exclude the full cost of the Travel Insurance purchased. You must notify all of your travel suppliers within 72 hours of discovering that you will need to cancel your trip (this includes being advised to cancel your trip by a doctor).

COVID-19 TRAVEL WAIVER (Travel Disruptions)

As the worldwide COVID-19 coronavirus pandemic remains ongoing at this time, I acknowledge that for this reason, and other reasons not reasonably foreseeable at this time, these travel plans may be interrupted or cancelled by the supplier that is providing them, a government entity or other third party over which Agency has no control. I further acknowledge that the supplier's own cancellation, rebooking and refund policies, subject to any applicable law that is now or may later be in effect, will govern my rights and remedies, including my right to receive a refund, in such an event. Moreover, I understand that should I elect to purchase travel insurance, the terms of the policy will dictate whether, and to what extent, coverage for any financial loss may exist under the circumstances. By signing below, I hereby agree to hold Agency harmless and release it from any and all liability for any damages, including but not limited to monetary losses, I may incur as a result of such interruption or cancellation of these travel plans.

FORCE MAJEURE

Each of the parties hereto shall be excused from the performance of its obligations hereunder in the event that performance of such obligations is prevented by a Force Majeure Event; provided, however, that such party shall be excused from performance of such obligations only for the duration and to the extent of said Force Majeure Event, and only if both parties agree in writing that a Force Majeure Event has occurred. For the purposes hereof, a "Force Majeure Event" means acts of God, war, national emergency, government regulation (including, quarantines or curfews), disaster, fire, hurricanes, earthquakes, strikes or other labor disputes, terrorism and responses thereto that arise after the signing of this agreement, in each case, beyond the reasonable control of a party hereto and not caused by the party seeking relief on that basis. If one of the parties hereto claims that a Force Majeure Event has occurred, it shall provide written notice thereof to the other party hereto within forty-eight (48) hours of the occurrence of the event or if not feasible a period reasonably longer depending on the magnitude of the Force Majeure Event. For the avoidance of doubt, downturns in general economic conditions shall not constitute a Force Majeure Event.

LIMITATION ON DAMAGES

Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, neither party hereto shall be liable to the other party hereto for (and both parties hereby knowingly forever waive) any special, indirect, incidental, consequential, punitive or exemplary damages arising out of or related to this Agreement. Notwithstanding, anything herein to the contrary, the reservation guests agree that the maximum cumulative liability of the company for all claims arising out of or related to this agreement shall not exceed the amount paid by the Group to the Company pursuant to this agreement.

SEVERABILITY

The invalidity, illegality or unenforceability of any one or more phrases, sentences, clauses or sections contained in this Agreement shall not affect the validity, legality or enforceability of the remaining portions of this Agreement, and such invalid, illegal or unenforceable portion shall be deemed automatically modified to the least extent necessary to render it enforceable and, so modified and together with all other unaffected portions of this Agreement, shall continue in full force and effect.
